**Directions:**

From park & ride, Rt 32 east 22 miles to merge Rt 97 south for 6 miles to merge Rt 50 east to exit for MD-665 Aris T Allen Road south towards Riva Road. Go 2.4 miles to Riva Road, turn right onto Riva Road and continue until you go across a bridge, then turn left. Mike's Crab House will be right there by the water at 3030 Riva Road, Riva, MD 21140.

We plan to arrive at about 11:00 AM
