From park & ride, Rt 32 east 6 miles to merge Rt 95 north for 4 miles to merge Rt 100 east, continue 16 miles to left on Magothy Bridge Road / MD-607 N/Hog Neck Road for a mile, turn right onto Fort Smallwood Road, go 2 miles, turn left on Colony Road, follow signs to Mike's North 9 about one mile. Mike's Crab House North will be right there by the water at 1402 Colony Rd., Pasadena, MD 21122.

We plan to arrive at about 12:00 Noon
